Statement on Primary School Sports Funding for Academic Yr 2013-14

Nature of support 2013/4

The school, through their self-evaluation procedures, has identified the need for additional sports provision for more able, for those who do not engage in sports regularly, for after school sports for EYFS and KS1 and to support the CPD of staff members.

In consultation with staff, it was decided to provide the following:

1. Multi skills sports coaching for Class One, Class two, Class Four and Class Five once a week, focusing on the National Curriculum and provided by an outside specialist coach
2. Multi skills club provision for Class One and Class two after school for one hour once a week provided by an outside specialist
3. Specialist sports provision two half days a week consisting of lunchtime play leaders followed by two afternoons of CPD ad high quality dance instruction
4. Specialist dance club specifically for EYFS and KS1 one evening a week
5. CPD package where by staff watch a specialist teach once a week fro a term, then team teach with them for a term, then finally use the specialist as a TA whilst they lead the provision. This then skills up the staff and is leaves a sustainable legacy for the following years.

The impact will be measured in terms of

1. Achieving primary School Sports quality mark Silver/Gold award
2. Ensuing 100% of children have the opportunity to take up an after school sport
3. Ensuring at least 80% of children attend an after school sport activity
4. Increase the number of intra and inter sporting activities
5. Increase active play within the school lunchtimes
