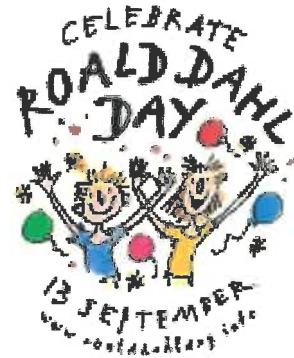




Dear Parents and Carers

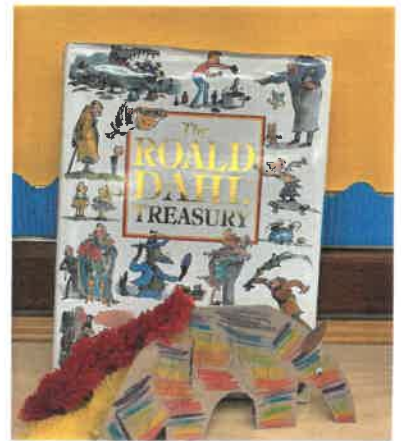


Roald Dahl Week

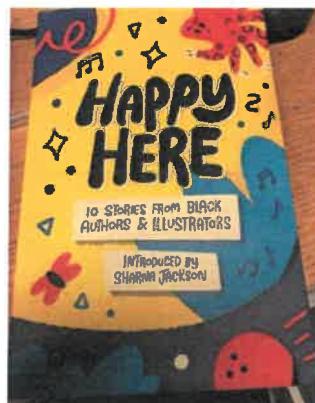
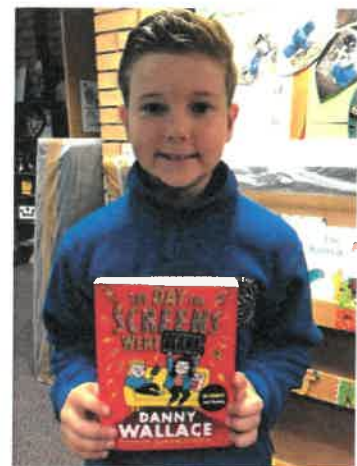
Summer reading Challenge

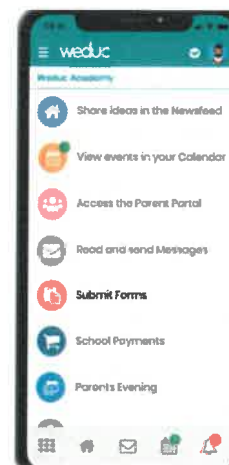

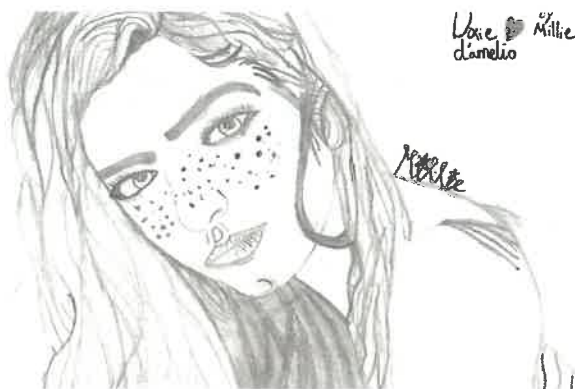


We are aware that this is new for all of us and we don't always have the technical answers but we will do our best if there are glitches on the system as we set things up from our end too. Please bear with us.
